> HOW MUCH COULD YOU WIN ? ? ?

That depends on how many numbers are in the Club, the prize pot is $50 \%$ of the total money paid in with $50 \%$ of that money being for the monthly draw and $50 \%$ for the Grand Draw. For example:

```
If we have 100 numbers paying \(£ 24\) each \(=£ 2400\) gives
50\% Winnings and 50\% For Funds = £1200 each Then
\(50 \%\) of \(£ 1200\) for the 10 draws \(=£ 600\)
= £60 each draw
= £15 for each of the 4 winners AND
\(50 \%\) of the \(£ 1200\) for Grand Draw \(=£ 600\) = £60 for each of the 10 winners
```

But if we have
200 numbers the winnings increase to $£ 30$ for each of the 4 winners in the 10 draws and £120 for each of the 10 winners in the Grand Draw

250 numbers the winnings increase to $£ 40$ for each of the 4 winners in the 10 draws and £150 for each of the 10 winners in the Grand Draw

SO the more numbers IN the more winnings OUT and more funds for the School !!
For 2023/24 the membership as of $31^{\text {st }}$ May 2024 will determine the amount of winnings.
