

School Dining

A cashless cafeteria system is operated in the Dining Hall at break (11.05 – 11.25am) and at lunch time from 1.30 to 2.15pm. This means that a wide range of individual items will be available for purchase. A two-course meal this year costs £2.50.

A packed lunch can be brought in from home and eaten here also.

It is worth noting that the school caterers provide a variety of breakfasts & snacks which may be purchased and consumed in the Dining Hall before school and during break. We do not allow students in Years 7-11 to go home to lunch unless there are exceptional circumstances.

As mentioned, we operate a biometric (thumbprint) cashless catering system in all three of our canteens across our school sites. Parents can top up their child's account via the school gateway, an online system also used for payment of school trips.

We also accept cash or cheques which can be paid at the school reception every day. This money will then be credited to the student's account the same day, or the next school day if money is paid in after 10am.

Students are able to use our pre-order point or pre order app from 4pm to 8.15am the following day to pre-order their break or lunch time meals. These pre-ordered items are then collected from a separate table, which helps to keep queues down to a minimum.
