



MUSIC AT CCGS

- Has more provision for music than any other school in East Kent
- Has fifteen music ensembles and clubs running EVERY WEEK, many of which are open to beginners
- Has four choirs – two of which are open to all
- Has seventeen visiting instrumental and voice teachers working in the department each week teaching one to one lessons
- Has an excellent track record at GCSE and A level – last year saw a 54% A* to A rate at GCSE and a 60% A* to B grade rate at A2.
- Provides music in the community – we play at local events such as The Canterbury Festival and the Dickens Festival
- We compete in national music competitions and have been overall winners of the National Festival of Music for Youth three times, leading to performances at the Royal Albert Hall, and Royal Festival Hall and the Birmingham Symphony Hall.
- We put on a school show every year for students of all ages to be involved in – this year is ***Matilda*** and last year was ***The Wizard of Oz***.
- We run an international tour every two years for our showcase ensembles (Senior Wind Band, Jazz Band and AVE) and travelled to Germany last summer. The next tour will be in 2026.
- We have outstanding provision of music for musicians and non-musicians alike.
