### **Equipment in Geography KS3, 4 and 5**

It is really important that students have basic equipment for lessons. In addition, we often do have resources in the classroom to enable students to get on with the tasks, but they are not always respected, returned and looked after. ## Year 11 Mock MFL Speaking Exams

Year 11 will all have a mock speaking exam as part of their mock exams in November and December. The exam will be conducted in the same way as the final GCSE exams will be. Students all have a set of general conversation questions that they need to learn for this exam. Parents can help by practising with students, even if they do not speak the language, as students need to practise saying their answers out loud to someone.

Miss Thelliez's classes, Mrs Walters's classes, Mrs Sotiri's Spanish class and those who are in Miss Griffith's double language class will all have their exams in the week of November 18th.

### French and Spanish vocab

As a languages department we highly recommend the use of Quizlet to help students learn their vocab. Many of the students who have achieved the top grades in languages at CCGS have been avid users of Quizlet for vocab learning since Y7 so it does work!

Quizlet is an app or a website, students can use either. Students can make an account for free and then should join the classes that we have created for their year groups, this means that they have unlimited free access to Quizlet and easy access to the sets that we have set up to help them learn their vocab each week.

To find the relevant class students can either follow the links that they were sent in September (they should just search Quizlet and Walters on their school account, and they will find the email) or they should search for CCGS Year 7 French 2024-2025 or CCGS Year 10 Spanish 2024-2025 . All classes are labelled in this way CCGS (Year Group) (Language) 2024-2025

#### P6 Reminder

We have recently had a number of students who have been asking staff to remove a P6 that they have incurred. Students have had a reminder this week about accepting the consequences of their actions so that each lesson can be a fresh start and behaviour/missing h/w etc can be quickly corrected.
