Overview of Job:

We require a well qualified and enthusiastic teacher of A Level Economics, which is a popular and growing subject within the school. You will be the Lead teacher of Economics for Year 12 and year 13.

An ability to teach GCSE Business Studies would be an advantage

Purpose of the Job:

To teach A Level Economics following the AQA syllabus.

To monitor progress of students via frequent testing of students with formative and summative assessments.

To deliver lessons which enthuse and motivate students to take ownership and responsibility for their learning.

Specific Responsibilities and Key Tasks:

Follow the AQA specification and the department curriculum plan, teaching both Micro and Macro Economics in Year 12 and Year 13.

To monitor and review schemes of work and the curriculum plan on a regular basis.

To identify any resource needs and liaise with the Head of Dept, who is the budget holder.

It is likely that there may be a small number of GCSE Business studies lessons to deliver, so an ability to teach this would be an advantage.
